Average tuition fees for UNIVERSITY students:

Canada: \$4,214

British Columbia: \$4,874

Average tuition fees for COLLEGE students:

British Columbia: \$3,075

Average tuition fees for TRADE SCHOOL students:

Tuition costs for each in-school technical training session depend on the trade and province / territory, but are typically \$200-\$800 per session.

- Personal savings is the most common source of funds followed by income from employment and money from family, partner and friends.
- About 85% of students enrolled in the most expensive programs reported personal savings as a source of funding.
- Student loans, an important source of financial support, were used by 26% of students.
- Grants or scholarships 29% of students received.
- Around 77% of full-time students used savings from jobs they had before starting the academic year.
- Some 64% used earnings gained while they went to school.
